We would like to suggest another reason for logging on: We have added a slide show of microscopic images which were taken by Dr. John Brodie and Shavante, (former genetic biologist Dr. Derek Hasdell) friends of ours in Japan. In 2001 they carried out dark field, phase contrast microscopy at the Olympus headquarters in Nagano, Japan, using state-of-the-art imaging equipment.

In these tests a drop of water was placed on a microscopic slide, which was then observed through the microscope during evaporation. Astounding images were taken of a drop of Tokyo tap water energised with

the Vortex Energiser. As the drop of water evaporated it revealed structures and light phenomena, which were due to the energising and clustering effect of the Vortex Energiser.

### News from Australia

We received an enquiry several months ago from a farmer in Queensland who is watering his vegetable farm from bore water. He bought a Vortex Energiser (VE) around 6 weeks ago with a view to cleaning up his dam as he has a large calcium problem from the bore water and was looking to clean up his dam. He stores the bore water in a dam and then pumps from the dam to trickle irrigate. He leaves the VE in the dam when he is not irrigating and moves it to the discharge side of the irrigation pumps when he irrigates. He reports that the dam water is much clearer, the calcium deposits have reduced, that his trees are white with blossom and that the parsley crop is healthy, large and very sweet. The latest feed-back is that he is now looking to increase the spacing on his parsley as their growth is such that they are becoming entangled.

He also reported that he normally picks every 2 weeks, but when I was speaking to him it had been a week since he last picked and the plants were almost ready

for picking again.

The real test will be this summer. In summer the heat is such that they only get very slow growth from the plants as they have difficulty coping with the heat of the day and recovering at night. The theory is that the plants should be more robust from being watered with energised water and if he can get reasonable growth through summer then his growing season will be effectively extended.

Another farmer in Finley New South Wales waters from the Hume Weir. This water runs in an irrigation system for around 100 kilometres in open channels before it gets to him. He runs a large herd of dairy cattle. He has only had a VE for around 4 weeks so it is early days. He has started by putting it in the cattle drinking troughs. He has the advantage that he gets a daily analysis of his milk production. The first thing that he has noticed is that the cell count dropped from around 200 to 150. He didn't attribute this to the VE until the cell count rose again to around 200 after several days of being

down. When he went to investigate he found that the cattle had pulled the VE out of the trough. He put it back into the trough and the cell count went back down to around 170.

The next call I had was to purchase another VE; he had taken it out of the watering trough to put into his irrigation channel to water the fields, and the cell count had risen again. The obvious advantage of the cell count on his milk being down is the quality of the milk, but if it stays down over the longer term then it will mean less problems with mastitis in the cattle and who knows what the long term effect on the cattle and the quality of the milk will be. We will have to wait patiently and see.

Both of the regions these farmers are located in are heading into a severe drought this summer and it will be interesting to see how they fare compared to their neighbours.
